Question:

This inquiry is to see if possibly the chipset (SP213ECA) has a Windows CE 5.0 driver developed for it.

Related/similar: I have a USB to serial converter. The SP213 chip is used. Could you please send me the windows XP driver or send me a link where I can find the driver for this converter?

Answer:

The SP213 is a Physical Layer device and therefore does not require software drivers. The SP213 family is a "PHY Layer" device and as such, utilizes no software drivers. You need to contact the vendor for the "Layer 2"/"Media Access Control Layer" chip to find the proper software you seek.

Question:

Do you recommend any filter capacitors on the inputs? (ttl/cmos)?

Answer:

Sipex does not recommend any filter caps on the inputs. If you do add filter caps, the corner frequency will be set by the capacitor and the input impedance of 400k Ω .
